Robert Glenn Johnson Jr. (June 28, 1931 – December 20, 2019), better known as **Junior Johnson**, was a stock car driver of the 1950s and 1960s. He won 50 races in his career before retiring in 1966. In the 1970s and 1980s, he became a racing team owner; winning championships with Cale Yarborough and Darrell Waltrip. Johnson was a master of dirt track racing. "The two best drivers I've ever competed against on dirt are Junior Johnson and Dick Hutcherson," said Ned Jarrett.

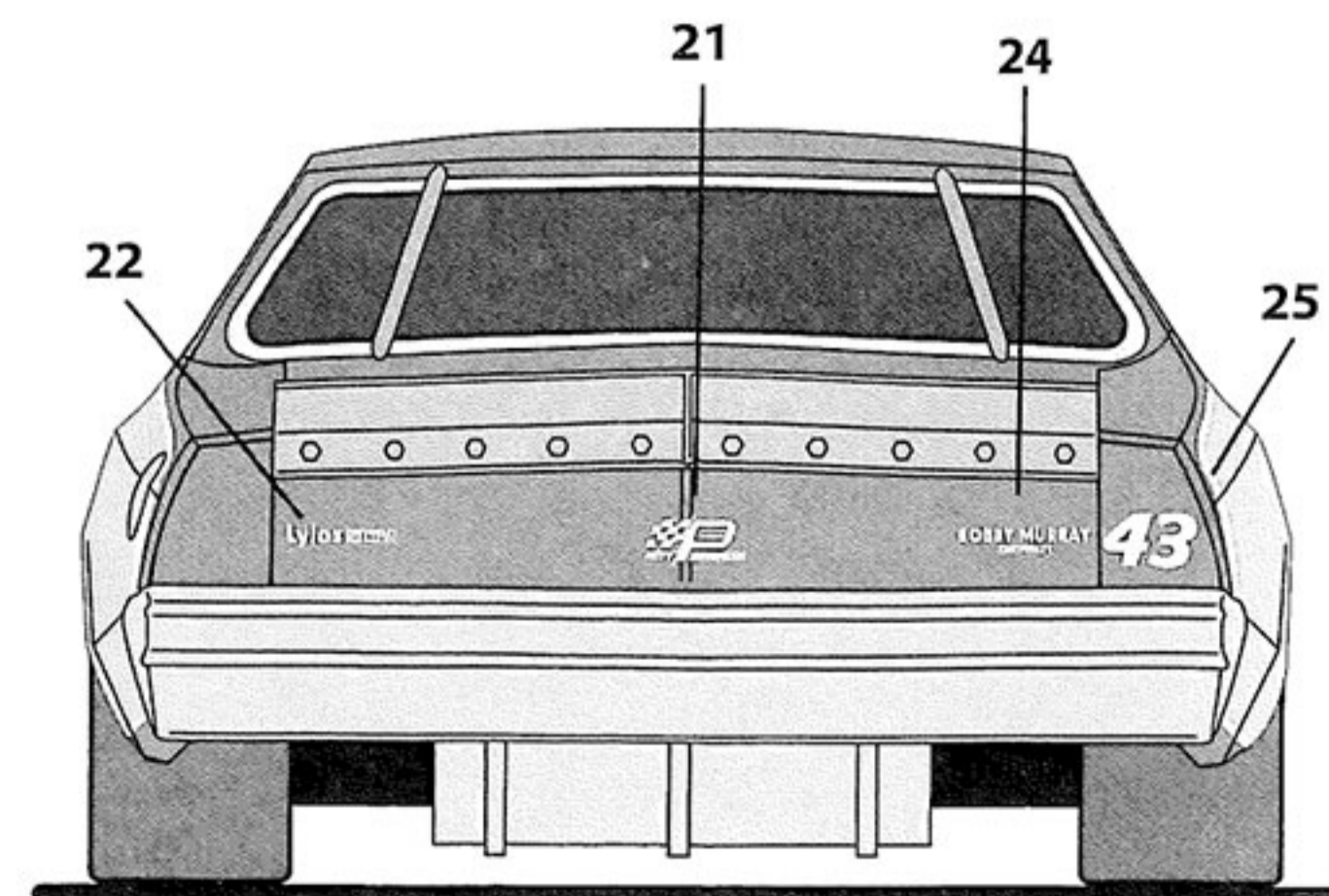
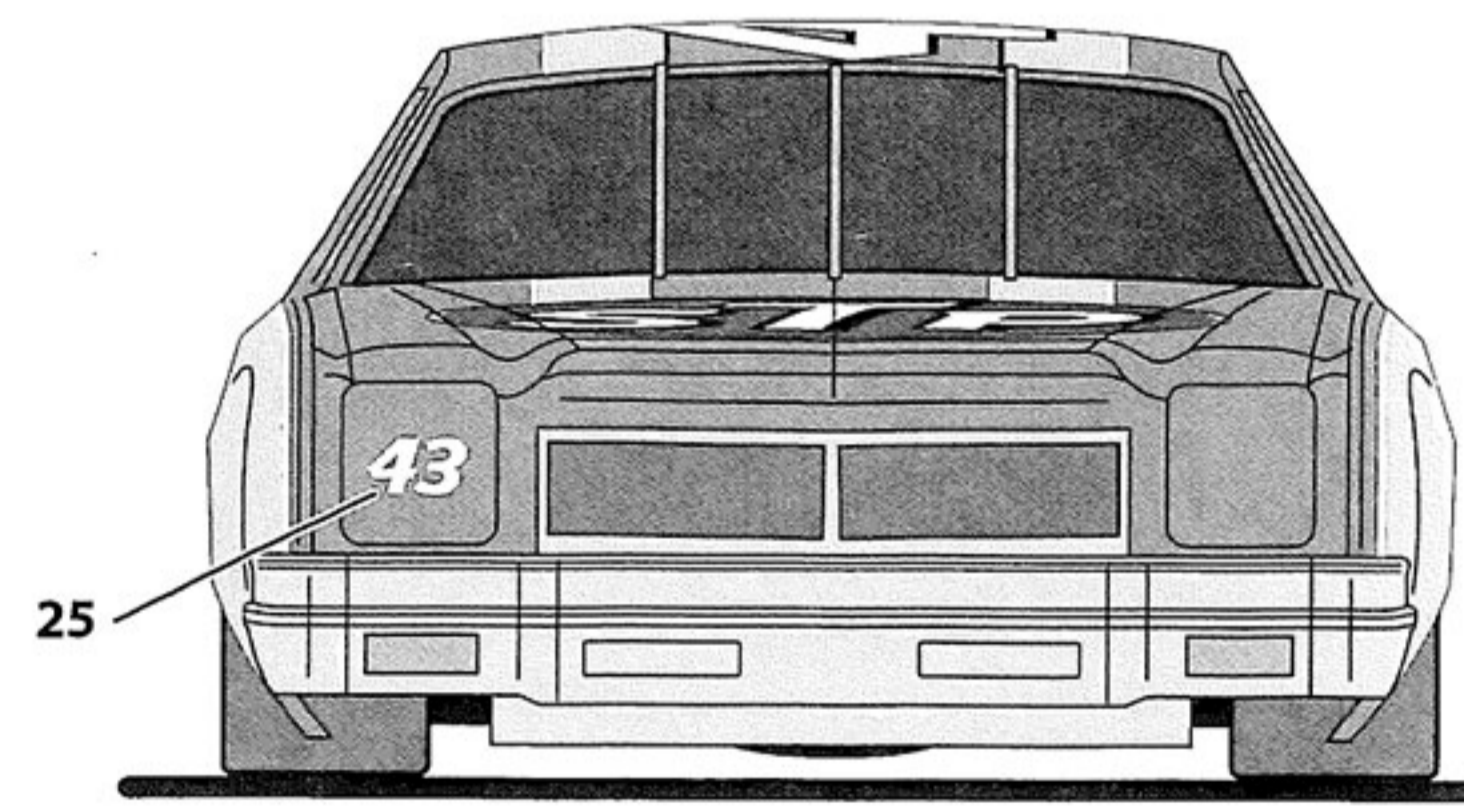
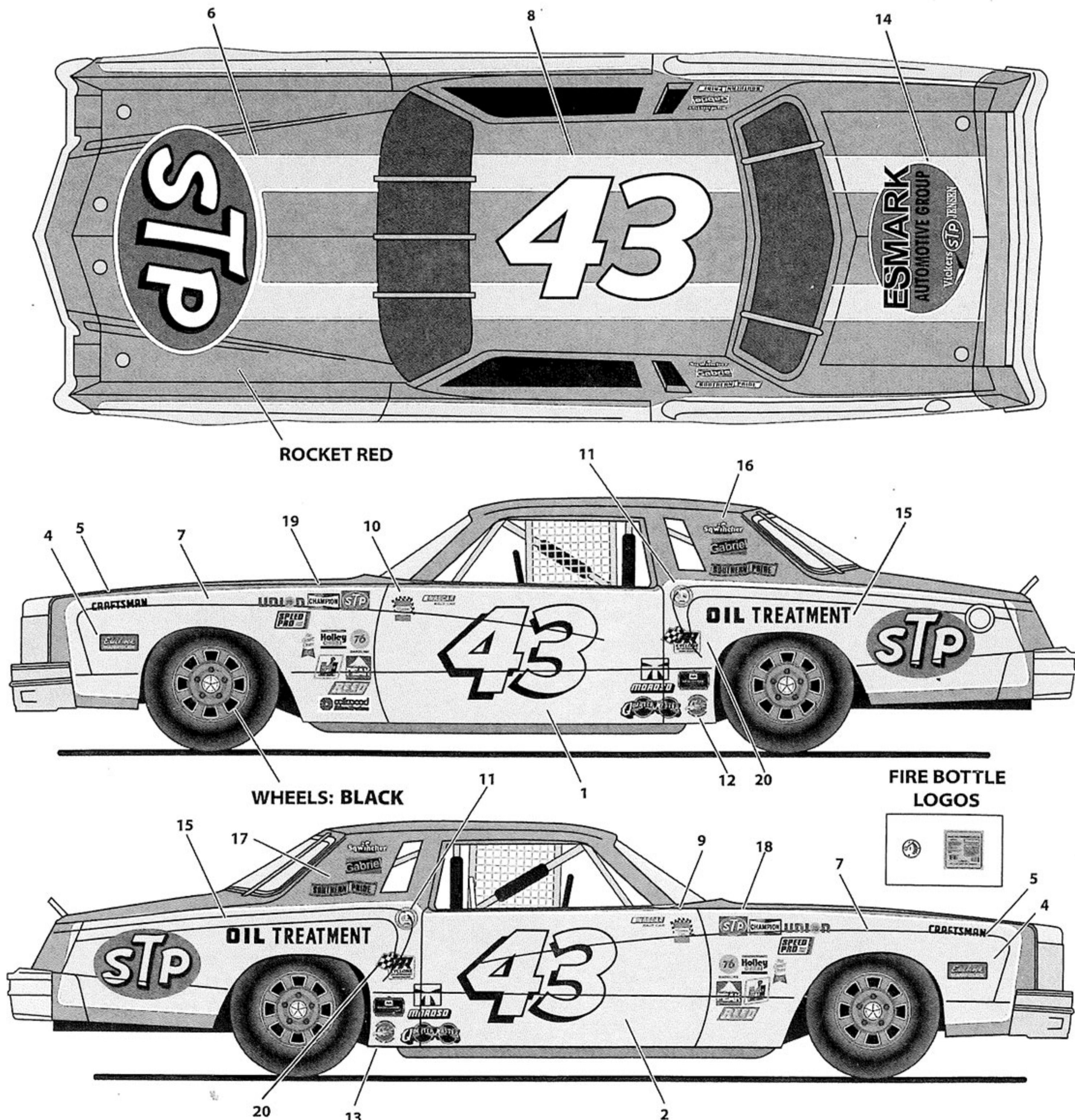
